**Boutique Contract:**

1. **All items must be handcrafted by an FSQ member.**
  
2. A \$5 non-refundable registration fee is required. FSQ will retain a commission of 10% on all sales.
3. Registration deadline is Monday April 2, 2013. Registrations and requests for identifying codes will be accepted on a first come/first served basis. FSQ Boutique reserves the right to limit quantities.
4. Crafters are required to work a shift/shifts in the boutique during the show. Time required is based on the quantity of items you are displaying in the boutique. You may sign up for extra shifts also.
  - 1 - 10 items    2 hours
  - 11+ items     3 hours
5. Crafts and an inventory list must be delivered to the Home Arts building at the Fairgrounds on Thursday, April 25 before 7 pm. I can make arrangements for drop-off at my home if this is not possible. Items **must** be picked up **1 hour after the closing** of the show on Sunday, April 28.
7. Checks will be mailed to you after the accounting is finished (usually 2-3 weeks).
8. Use of e-mail saves the guild money. Be sure your e-mail is correct and check it frequently.
