Red Hot Poker

Learn to applique with attitude - the Piece O' Cake way! You will learn to applique with attitude using perle cotton and a variety of stitches. This method is fast and fun and very cute! You can applique on a cotton tea towel or make a block to use in a pillow or small quilt.

This is a 1-day class. I will provide a pattern for each student in class.

Supply List

Book:

I recommend these books and DVD by Piece O' Cake Designs but they are not required for class.

Fabric:

Pre-wash all fabric before class. It appliques better!

Background Fabric:

- One tea towel OR

- 1 square 16" x 16" to be used as background.

Applique Fabric:

- A variety of large scraps for flowers, leaves, stems, and vase.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Small, sharp, paper scissors
- Small, sharp, fabric scissors
- One 14" x 14" square of clear upholstery vinyl in a medium weight to make a placement overlay. Keep the tissue paper that comes with the vinyl.
- An ultra fine point Sharpie marker if you make an overlay.
- One sheet of clear, heavy weight, self-adhesive laminate – available at most office supply stores or on our website (pieceocake.com). Get the single-sided sheets, not the 2-sided pouches. Avoid repositionable laminate.
- I will supply you with a needle and some 1/2" sequin pins. You may need additional pins. I prefer 1/2" sequin pins for pinning appliqué.
- I will have some size 12 and 16 Prescencia perle cotton thread for you to use in class or you can bring your own from home.
- Bohin or Sewline mechanical pencil with white lead OR General's charcoal pencil in white to use on medium to dark fabric.
- Bohin or Sewline mechanical pencil with gray ceramic lead for light fabric.
- A sandpaper board or a sheet of fine grain sandpaper if you don't have a board.
- Baggies for your templates
- **Optional** - A light and an extension cord in case the room is dark.
- **Optional** - Many people find that applique is easier if they have a pillow in their lap to rest their forearms on. It's a good idea to bring a pillow to class for this purpose.
