

# Appliqué with Folded Cutwork

Discover how you can use this “fold and cut” technique to create your own original designs for appliqué. Learn to cut nearly a dozen different types of patterns and begin to stitch a block using the needle-turn appliqué technique. Full day. Intermediate level.

Supply list:

Plain (typing) paper cut into 8" squares (15-20 pieces)

Pencil and eraser

Paper scissors

Two 14" squares of freezer paper

15" background block

15" square of fabric for appliqué

Fabric marking pencil

Thread to match appliqué fabric

Needles for appliqué (or will be available for purchase in class)

Small pins for appliqué

Small scissors

For classroom: one chalk board and one felt or cork board for pin-ups.
