

**Square Bulls-Eye
Supply List**
Approximate size 40"x60"

Fabrics

You will need a large variety of fabrics, at least 15 to 20 different fabrics (more, if you wish)

Bring large scraps (at least 9"-10" square, quarter yards, half yards, etc.)

One-quarter yard for first border.

Leftover scraps for the second border.

2 yards for the backing and sleeve.

One-half yard for binding.

Batting.

Other Supplies

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

9-1/2" square ruler for sizing squares

sharp pointed scissors for cutting away fabric

sewing machine with 1/4" foot

neutral thread

specialty threads, rayon, metallics, etc.

design wall (you can use your batting for this or a flannel-backed plastic table cloth)

basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, seam ripper etc.).

Pre-class homework

To save time in class, cut a variety of 9" and 6" squares from the above selected fabrics. You will need 35 of each to make a quilt 38" by 58".
