

"Sculpting with the Quilting Stitch" Class Supply List

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Although we will discuss and look both hand- and machine-quilted samples, we will create our samples using the machine because the class is relatively short.

Includes a variety of fabrics and battings as well as handouts and other miscellaneous supplies.

- ❖ 1.5-4 yards bleached or unbleached 100% cotton muslin
- ❖ Regular sewing thread to match your cloth (white, cream, ecru, or tan)
- ❖ Various batting scraps, including flannel, cotton, wool, polyester, blends. Bring what you have and be prepared to swap. Scraps as small as 8" per side will work fine. I will also bring a variety of battings for students to experiment with.
- ❖ Sewing machine in good working order (you should be able to lower or cover the feed dogs). Please be familiar with your machine—this is not a sewing class.
- ❖ Extra machine needles and bobbins (optional: prewind some bobbins)
- ❖ Hand sewing needles (optional: thimble)
- ❖ Standard foot
- ❖ Free-motion quilting or darning foot
- ❖ (Optional) Walking foot
- ❖ (Optional) Cording or couching foot
- ❖ Extension cords/Power strips as needed for the space
- ❖ Iron/Ironing surface—we only need one for every 3-4 students
- ❖ Seam ripper
- ❖ (Optional) Small embroidery scissors
- ❖ Fabric shears
- ❖ Scissors (for paper/plastic)
- ❖ Pencil, eraser, sharpener
- ❖ Permanent fabric pen or marker
- ❖ Safety pin
